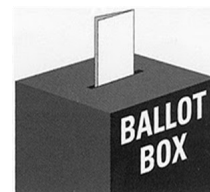


Vote **Arbury Ward** Mike Todd-Jones

Only Labour can beat the Lib Dems in Arbury, with less than 300 votes in it last year.

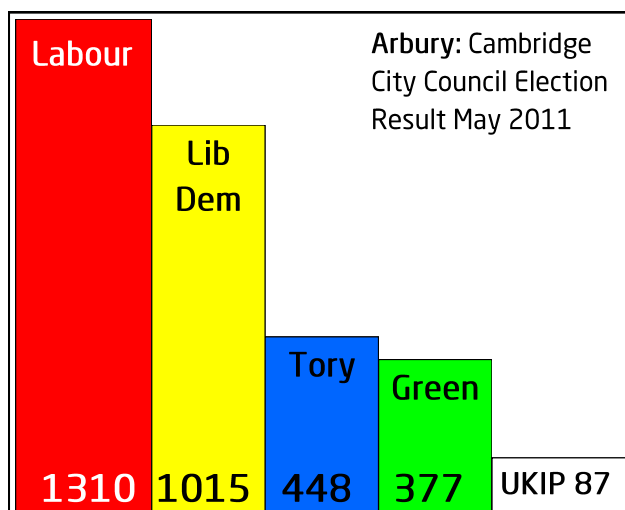
Vote Labour to help us deliver our 'Contract with Cambridge' so that Arbury residents will benefit:

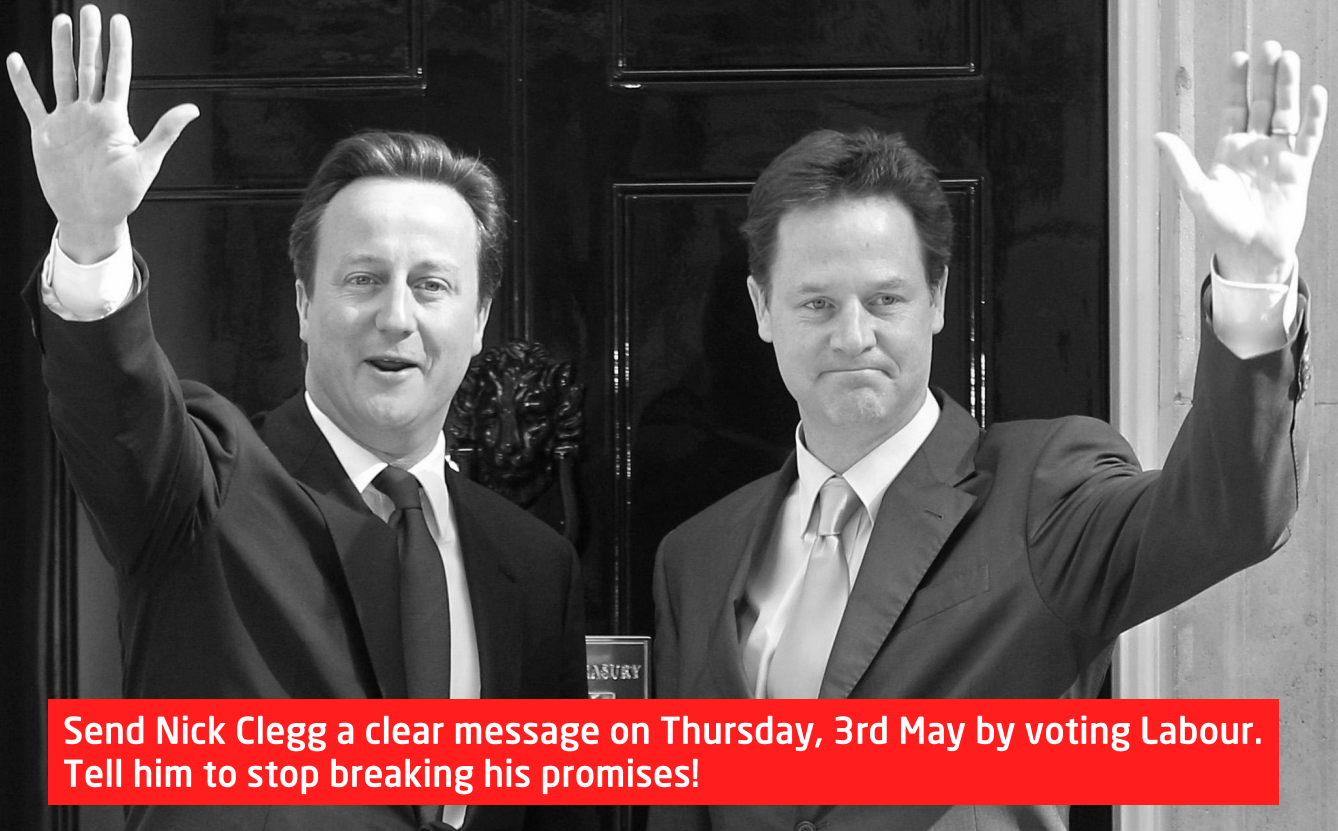
