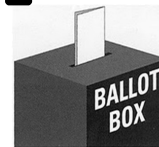

Why do local Lib Dems want to protect rogue landlords?

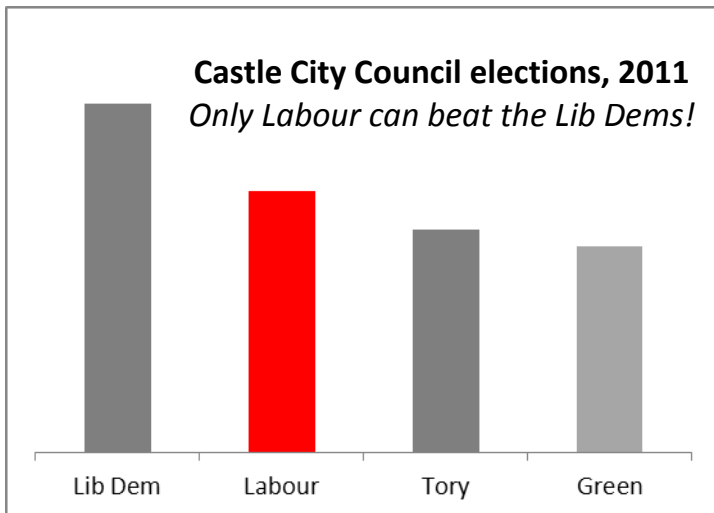
