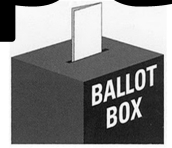


Vote **King's Hedges** Nigel Gawthrope Vote Labour on Thursday, 3rd May 2012

- ◆ The lack of dog dirt bins around the green areas of the ward

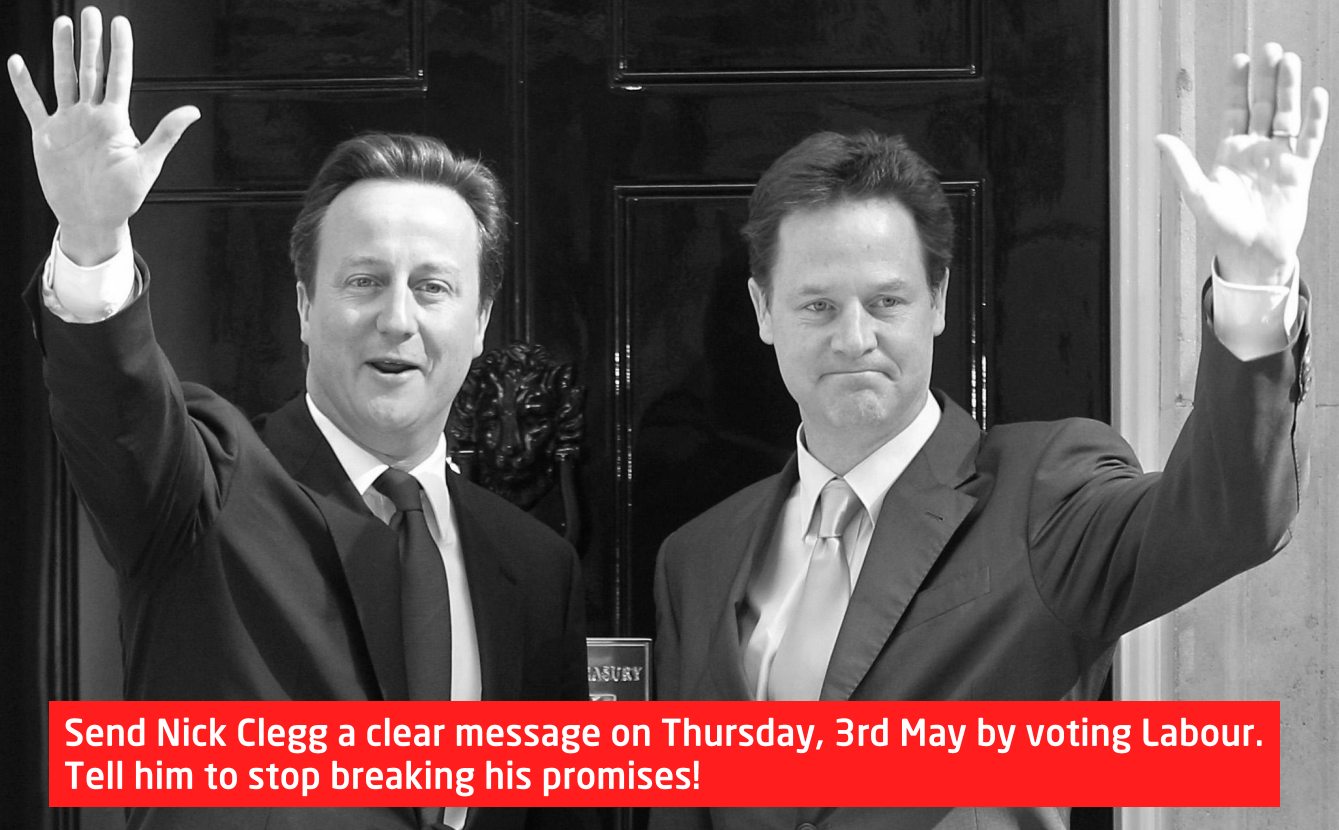
"Labour listens to your concerns and we will take action to deal with these problems. If elected I will work with Labour's Cllr Kevin Price to get a better deal for King's Hedges."
