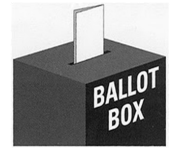

Sarah says, "The environment is important to me..."

- **Recycling** I supported Labour councillors who ensured that, from July, the current recycling scheme will be extended to include a wider range of plastics. We will continue to campaign for improved recycling, especially for those living in flats, sheltered accommodation and college housing.
- **Green issues** I will work for the creation of an energy co-op for local residents: for more allotments; to support green and sustainable local businesses; for better and safer cycleways and for the reinstatement of a full-time council cycling officer.
- **Green spaces** As a keen birdwatcher, I care about the preservation of Newnham's trees and green spaces, particularly the local river ecosystem and Paradise Nature Reserve, which supports a variety of wildlife. I, therefore, share local concerns about inappropriate development of the Owlstone Croft site but I believe that planning issues should not be exploited for political gain. The key point is that residents' views are heard. I will fight for this but the Coalition's recent Localism Act will make this much harder."

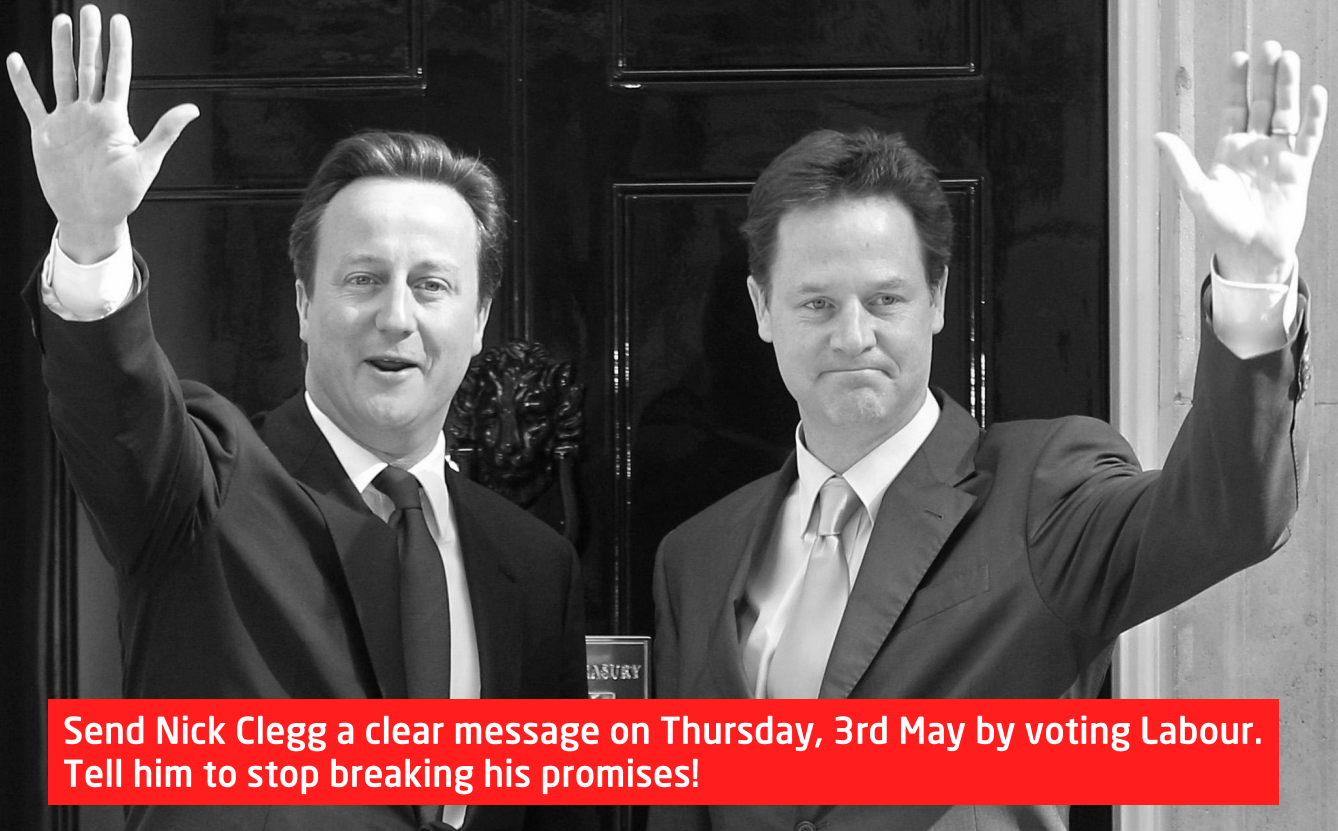
