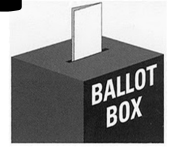


Vote **West Chesterton** Mike Sargeant Vote Labour on Thursday, 3rd May 2012

- Improved street cleaning and litter collection

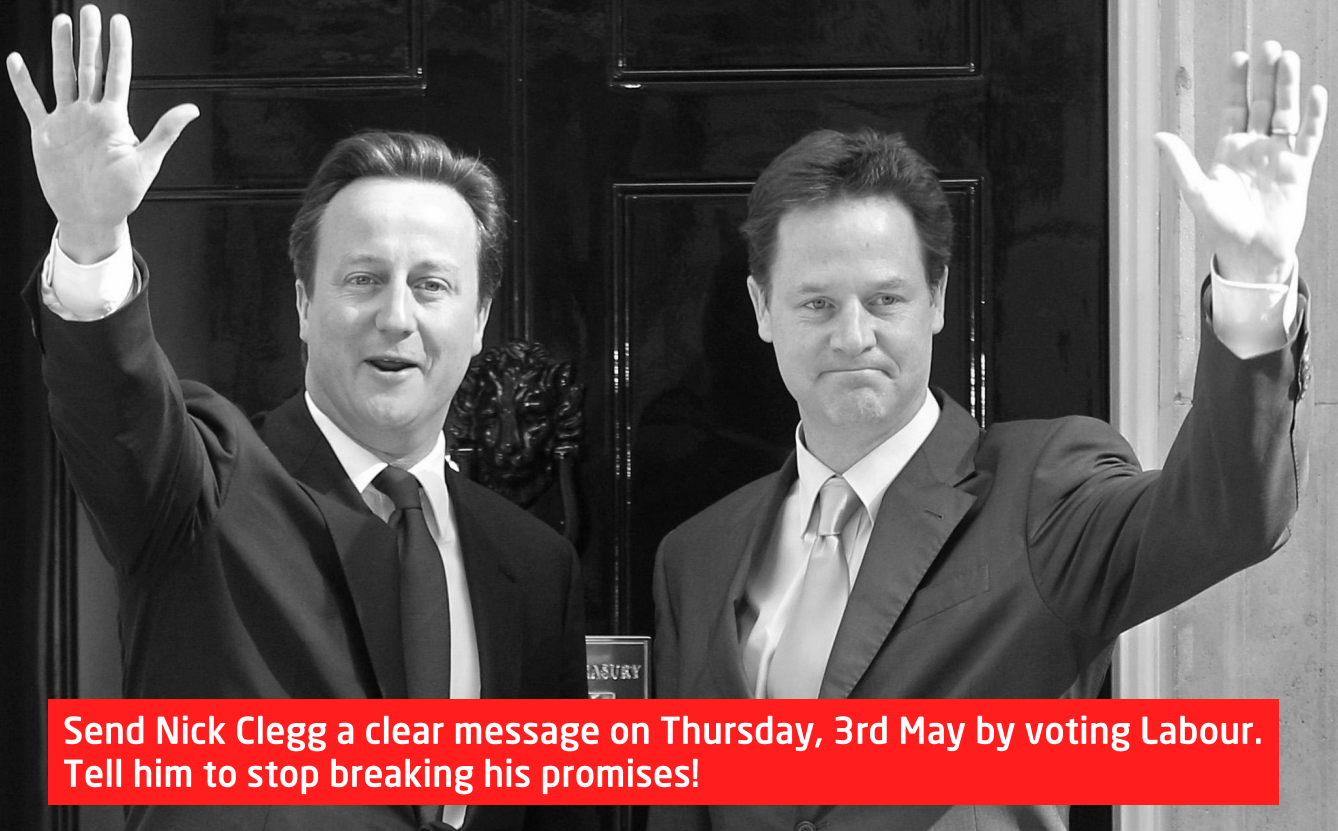
